## Amendment on decision taken in 23<sup>rd</sup> Covid Cell Committee

# For the students of the <u>School of Computing and Information Technology</u> and the <u>Department of Computer Applications</u>:

- The students who cannot report to the university for physical mode of lab classes, may opt for lab courses in online mode.
- For the concerned Departments, lab courses will be held in hybrid mode <u>only</u> during Nov 17<sup>th</sup> to Dec 10<sup>th</sup>, 2021.

#### For the students of all other departments (with lab courses in the programme):

- The lab experiments involve physical setups/processes/machines and thus, cannot be easily virtualized. Hence, the university has decided to run the lab courses only in offline/physical mode with a flexibility to make a choice of time slot for attending the labs sessions.
- If any student is unable to attend lab courses in physical mode during Nov 17<sup>th</sup> to Dec 10<sup>th</sup> 2021, they can complete the same in January 2022.
- The departments are running the lab courses in succession so that the student can benefit the most from the opportunity & physical resources of the labs.

**Note:** These changes are only for Lab classes the End Term Examination will be held only in physical mode as per the previous mail.
