Dear Students

Greetings!!

Hope you and all your family members are enjoying good health.

1. Refer university circular dated 15 Jan 2021 regarding reopening of campus to resume academic activities with effect from 15 Feb 2021 for final year UG and PG students. In view of the latest government directives (attached) vide letter no. 3(7) Shiksha-4/2014 dated 02.02.2021, please note the opening of University has been allowed for all the students. In this context, please note and follow the instructions below: -

- (a) It is intimated that University has decided to start re-opening campus in staggered manner as per following schedule.
 - i. Reporting of hosteler of prefinal year students is on 23 Feb 2021 of all courses. The offline classes will start for hostelers and day scholars on 02 Mar 2021 and in online mode till then.
 - ii. Reporting of hosteler of 2nd year B Tech, and 3rd and 2nd year B Arch and BALLAB students for offline classes 02 Mar 2021. The offline classes will start for hostelers and day scholars on 09 Mar 2021 and in online mode till then.
 - Reporting of hosteler of first year students for offline classes 09 Mar 2021 of all courses. The offline classes will start for hostelers and day scholars on 16 Mar 2021 and in online mode till then.
 - iv. All students will be quarantined for 07 days on arrival and would attend online classes in this period.
- (b) To ensure completion of session on time, online classes will commence for all students from 15 Feb 2021 except 1st year students.
- (c) Online classes for first year students will commence from 10 Mar 2021.

2. As you know, the university is already operating effectively at 100% strength for faculty and staff since mid-Jun 2020 and has put in place various preventive measure to ensure safety of all stake holders.

3. The university is in the process of preparing the campus and hostels for arrival of students in Feb / Mar 2021 as per schedule mentioned above. Detailed Standard Protocols have already been shared with students. However, some salient features of the protocols for day scholars and hostelers are reproduced below for quick reference: -

- (a) Protocols for day scholars (attached at Annexure 1).
- (b) Protocols for hostlers (attached at Annexure 2).
- (c) General preventive measures for safety (attached at Annexure 3).

4. It is reiterated that students willing to attend offline classes need to bring written consent of their parents. However, for students who are not coming to campus, the classes will continue in online mode.



A student is also required to furnish the following applicable undertaking / declaration on arrival: -

(a) Negative COVID -19 RTPCR certificate which should not be older than 07 days.

- (b) Self-declaration by all day scholars and hostlers (attached at Annexure 4).
- (c) Undertaking by parents for both day scholars and hostelers (attached at Annexure 5).
- (d) Declaration for hostel stay (attached at Annexure 6).

6. All students, who wish to avail hostel facility, may give a written request through MUJ mail id to Mr. Shahid Jamal (email id: <u>info.jaipur@goodhostspaces.com</u>) with information to respective HoD.

7. It is prudent that a proper planning should be done at all level by the university to manage the academic and hostel facilities in the given scenario. For this purpose, students are requested to fill the google form at least 07 days prior to arrival so that the effective operating procedures can be put in place to ensure safety of the students and all involved in the operations of various facilities.
