**Dear Students** 

Greetings!!

I take this opportunity to wish you and your family members a happy Holi!!

The university COVID-19 team has reassessed the situation and based on the recommendations of the committee, the university has decided to continue classes in Hybrid mode from 30 Mar 2021 for the benefit of the students. All students are advised to always maintain adequate social distance and wear mask while in the university/ hostel premises.

The university has decided to conduct classes in offline mode for day scholars and hostellers in a staggered manner. Offline Classes for students residing in the hostel would be conducted on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday and they should attend classes in online mode on Tuesday and Thursday. Similarly, classes in offline mode for day-scholars would be conducted on Tuesday and Thursday and they should attend classes in online mode on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday. However, online classes would be continued hitherto on all days for students those who decide not to join in offline mode. This routine would be implemented with effect from 30 Mar 2021.

It is observed that lot of students from hostels have moved to their native places for Holi celebrations. All students joining back in the hostel are required to come with negative RT-PCR certificate which should not be older than 72 hours as per Rajasthan Government Directives.

Parents accompanying the students are also requested to come with negative RTPCR certificate. The parents are further requested to follow the guidelines of university / hostel management when they are in university / hostel premises.

All Day Scholars are also advised to come with Negative RTPCR certificate when returning for offline classes first time which should not be older than 72 hours.

Please stay safe during this festive season and take good care of yourself and all your family members.
