






# "Tree Plantation Drive at Manipal University Jaipur" 13th August, 2020 Department of Economics Manipal University Jaipur



## Societal Outreach Program - Environmental and Health awareness in relation to the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan and COVID-19 pandemic.

#### **December 24th, 2021**

The Department of Biosciences and Department of Physics in collaboration with the Directorate of Student Welfare (DSW) and BIOTECH CLUB organized an online societal connect and outreach program entitled "Environmental and Health awareness in relation to COVID-19 pandemic and the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan" at Sai Horizon Senior Secondary School, Sanjhariya from 10:00 AM to 12:00 PM.

The event primarily focused on imparting knowledge on the importance of health and disease awareness in times of the ongoing deadly COVID-19 pandemic alongside the significance of environmental health and the Swachh Bharat initiative. The program was organized under the supervision of Dr. Mousumi Debnath, Outreach coordinator, Department of Biosciences, Faculty Coordinator of Biotech Club. The first part of the event commenced with a welcome speech addressed by Ms. Anshulika Saxena who anchored the event. An interactive session by Dr. Mousumi Debnath was discussed with the students of Sai Horizon on the takeaway from the session on Health and environment in correlation to COVID 19 new wave of the variant OMICRON was discussed








Fig-1,2,3,4- Guiding children for making envelop through paper




Fig- 7,8,9 - Childeren showing the envelope made by them




