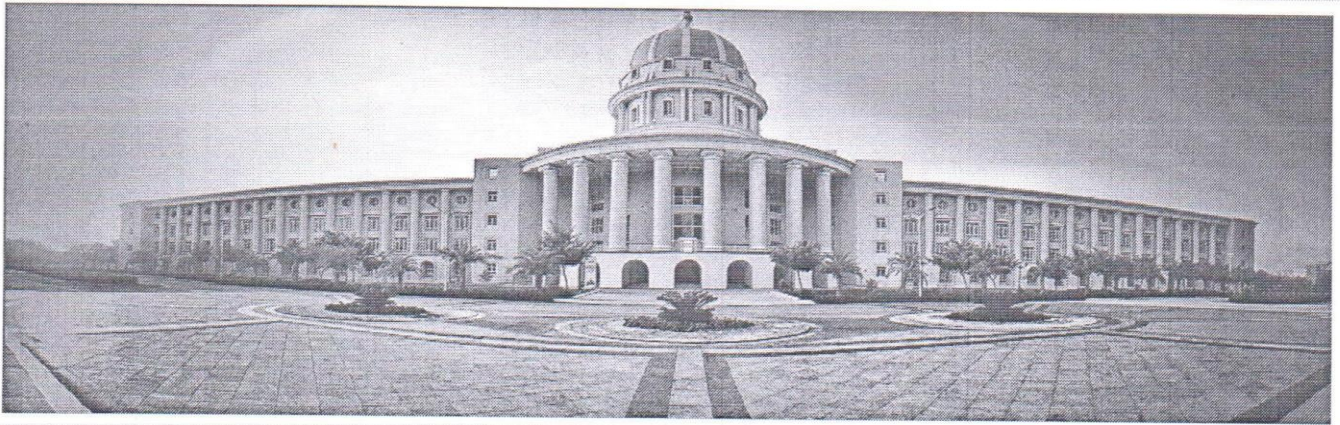

1. Introduction of the Event

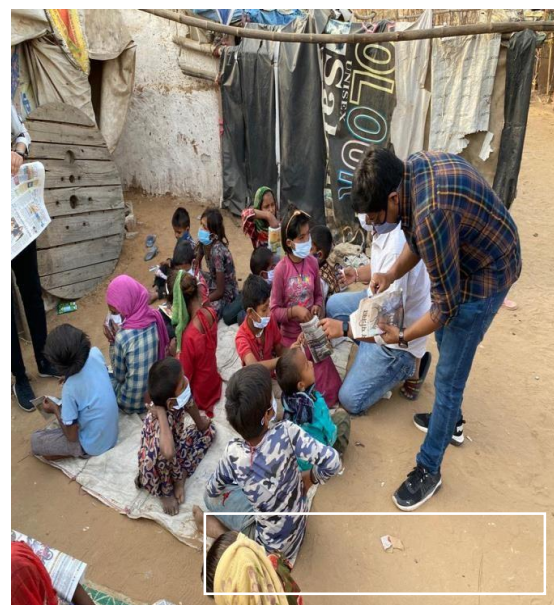


Fig-1,2,3,4- Guiding children for making envelop through paper

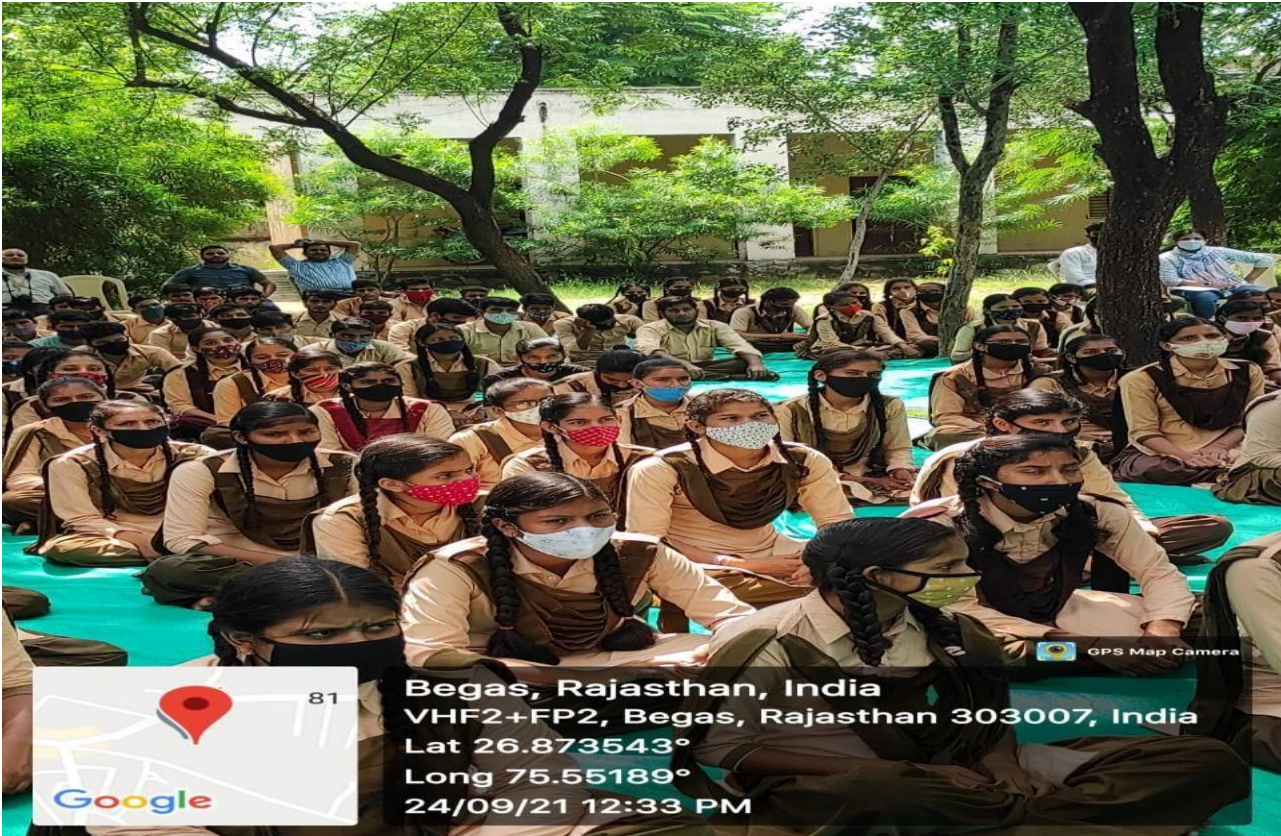
