




Fig: Quiz for Final Round


Brief Description of the event

Were distribute amongst the participants based on their performance.






Fig 1 Discord server






Fig 2 Jam board with notes make by Group 2




Fig 3 Discord with Participants






Fig 4 Jam board of Group 1


5.Brief Description of the event




