My Dear Students and Parents,

Greetings from Manipal University Jaipur (MUJ)...!!

Hope you and all your family members are safe and enjoying good health.

The Rajasthan state Government has issued the guidelines to re-open the educational institutions from 1st September 2021 onwards. The COVID '19 Cell at MUJ has thoroughly examined the directives and after due deliberations, it has been decided for "Campus and Hostels Reopening" from 1st September 2021 onwards".

The proposed outlines for the smooth arrival of the students to the campus, hostels, and commencement of the hybrid mode of classes (Physical and Online classes) are as follows-

- For Final Year and fourth year (of five-year degree) program Students from Wednesday 1st September 2021 onwards.
- For 3rd Year Students from Wednesday 8th September onwards.
- For 2nd Year Students from Wednesday 15th September onwards.
- During the upcoming odd semesters, the theory classes will be held in hybrid mode, half of the students will attend the online classes and remaining half of the student will attend in physical mode. However, Mid-Term Exam (MTE) will be held in online mode. In this regard more detailed information will be shared by Directorate of Academics (DoA)/Examination Office.
- Students are permitted to the campus and hostels in a graded manner considering the health and safety precautions. Students will have to follow proper code of conduct and SOPs with respect to COVID-19 as already been promulgated to you all time and again. The safety protocols related to campus and hostel can also be accessed from MUJ website.

- For physical reporting at MUJ campus and hostels, students need to submit the following
 - i) Parents' written consent and
 - ii) Copy of vaccination certificate of at least one jab of vaccination mandatory for physical reporting at campus/hostel.
- Else, they can continue their education through online mode till the first Jab of vaccination. This is to inform you that MUJ management has decided to arrange the 2nd Jab of Vaccination to all students at MUJ in a graded manner once they are here.
- No Mask No entry will be followed strictly in campus as well as hostel.
- Detailed hostel and mess fees plan will be shared by Chief warden shortly.
- Students are strictly advised to deposit their hostel and mess fees before arrival in hostel. Students are directed to retain a copy of fee receipt on their first arrival to the hostel.

The above schedule is tentative and would change if any fresh directives are received from the government.
