



Code of Conduct for Students

The core mission of the University is to promote innovative and interdisciplinary learning, and to transform young minds into competent professionals with good human values.

The code of student conduct is established to foster and protect the mission of the university.

- 1. Student ID card:** Students should wear their ID cards all the time in University premises.
- 2. Dress Code:** Students will wear clean, neat, decent, and presentable clothing. Visiting students are also expected to observe the dress code.
Boys: They should wear collared t-shirts/ half or full sleeves shirts and jeans/ trousers with shoes and socks.
Girls: They should wear t shirts/shirts and jeans /trousers or salwar kameez with formal footwear.
Student must wear clothes which are not too revealing or inappropriate. Students must avoid clothes with stamps that are offensive or inappropriate. No knee cut/ teared jeans are permitted inside the University campus.
- 3. Timings:** Timings to visit sports field, library and classes are already specified to the students. So, they should restrict themselves to the timings as specified.
- 4. Public Demonstration of Affection:** Demonstration of affection is not permitted in the campus. The MUJ staff and security personnel on duty are authorized to check the identity card of students who are involved in public demonstration of affection. Parents of the involved students will be informed, and appropriate disciplinary action will be initiated.
- 5. Harassment/Threatening:** Harassment, whether written, verbal, sexual, physical, emotional, or racial, is a serious offence and will not be tolerated. Students involvement in any such case will lead to necessary disciplinary action.



- 6. Respect for Authority:** Students will demonstrate respect for all staff and students. Students are expected to recognize and comply with the authority held by the institution/ university and its staff. Requests made to them by staff are expected to be followed and adhered to.
- 7. Fighting / Criminal Assault:** Any student involved in or encouraging the involvement of other student in fighting in the vicinity of Manipal University Jaipur will be followed by necessary disciplinary action.
- 8. Bullying/Intimidation/Swarming:** No student will participate in or initiate any form of bullying, intimidation or swarming. Persistent disregard would result in necessary disciplinary action.
- 9. Graffiti / Vandalism (property and /or equipment):** Students are responsible for damage/ distortion of any equipment or property loaned to or used by them. Damage, distortion, or tampering is a serious offence and will result in necessary disciplinary action.
- 10. Use of Substance:** University prohibits the illegal or unauthorized consumption, possession, distribution or sale of alcohol, illegal substances or other drugs in University premises as well as in it's close vicinity. No smoking in/out MUJ Complex/ Hostel/ FH around 100 mts from MUJ.
- 11. Any other:** No student will play/feed the dogs/cats in the MUJ Campus/Hostel Complex.
