The group found that the incomplete constructions of toilets are creating the problems related to sanitation. Many a toilet had no doors or had small pit holes. It was observed by the group that there was little or no awareness in the villagers about the water borne diseases. Many open drains, clogged drains etc. were found due to the lack of awareness. The team disseminated the relevant information to villagers and students at nearby schools. Youth showed more interest in the awareness.

Overall, the condition of village was average. Condition of Roads, Sanitation and Drains was found bad. Local bodies should focus on drainage system because the water was getting collected on the road which causes the pits on roads. Condition of government school was not so satisfactory, and the level of cleanliness was also very low. Sarpanch and other local leaders should focus on these primary issues.
