I. Name of the Program/Activity and Resource Person:

The proposed program is a webinar cum workshop (online) on *Various scholarships offered by Government of France and Writing of CV and Statement of Purpose.*

Ms Maud Le Bars is South Asia Area Manager for Rennes School of Business, France. She is an alumni of Rennes School of Business with 18 years of experience in HR and Higher Education who worked for the FAO, a UN Organisation, P&G, Adecco and in Europe, New Zealand and South East Asia. She is the former Chairman of the Higher Education Committee of the Indo French Chamber of Commerce, this year awardee of the Woman of the Year Award from the prestigious Council for UN Relations, and is an official Trade Advisor for the French Government.

Ms Saudamini Deo is a writer, photographer, and translator from Jaipur, India. She has studied English and comparative literatures at Miranda House and Jadavpur University. Her words and images have been published in *Scroll.in*, *Words Without Borders*, *3:AM Magazine*, *Sangam House Reader*, *Sultan's Seal*, *Seagull Books catalogue*, *Documentum*, etc. She is also the co-founding editor of the esoteric literary journal RIC Journal. Her short story *The Autobiography of a Girl from an Undiscovered Planet* was shortlisted for the DWL short story contest in 2017 and she was awarded the Sangam House residency for fiction in 2018. She has read papers in national and international conferences, and also regularly collaborates on medico-literary articles for international medical journals like *The Lancet Neurology*, *The Lancet Oncology*, *Journal of the Neurological Sciences*, *European Journal of Internal Medicine*, etc. She also co-edited *Vith Colloque International De Pathographie* published in 2017 by De Bocard, Paris. At present, she is working as Manager of Campus France, Rajasthan. Campus France is the academic arm of the embassy of France in India.

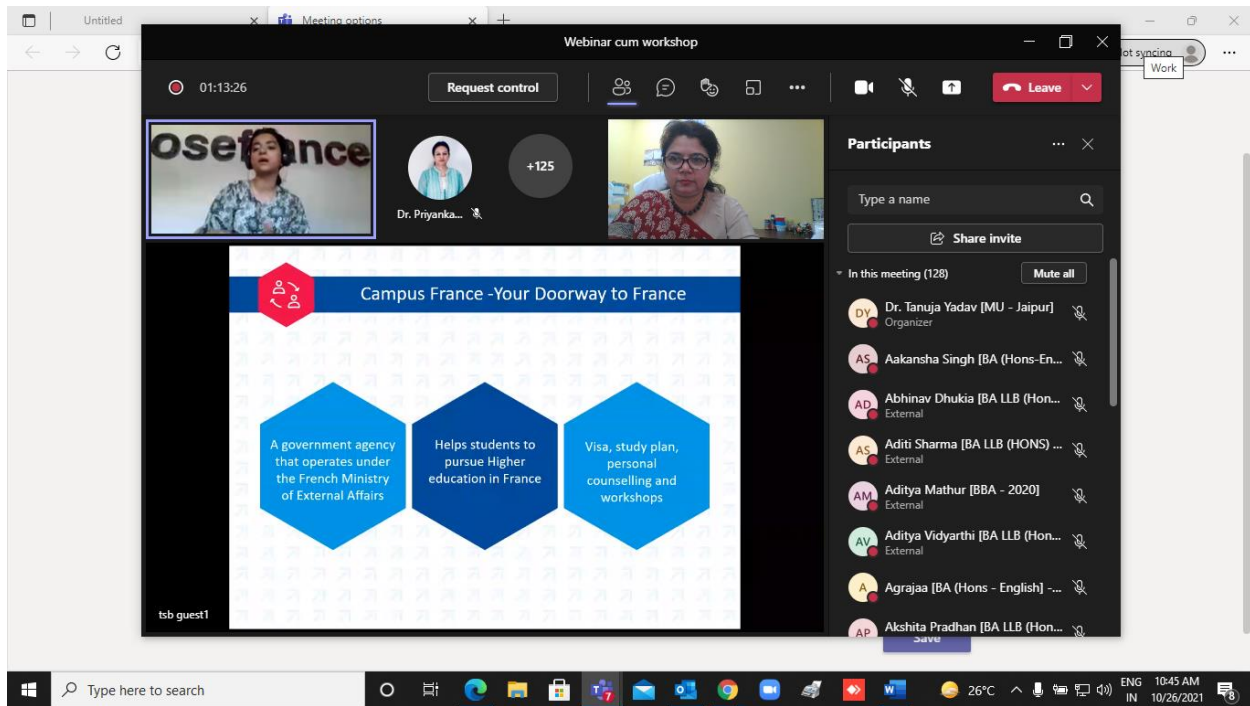
