Day 1: 12 April 2022

SESSION 1: THE CLASSICAL THEORY OF LITERATURE:

This session focused on the origins of classical drama, and its various features and characteristics. The session examined the relevance of classical theories of literature expounded by Plato and Aristotle in understanding a literary text. It aims to provide a detailed understanding of the notion of tragedy, the concept of a tragic hero, and the function of tragedy, and Dr. Praveen Shetty was the resource person.

SESSION 2: ROMANTIC THEORY OF POETRY

The session focused on the notions of poetry in European Romantic poetry. Examining the social and political conditions in Europe that led to the rise of the literary (and artistic) movement of Romanticism, it analyses the notion of poetic creation and features of romantic

poetry in Europe. Select poems from English writers of the Romantic Age were used to illustrate the relation between the theories of poetry and their application in understanding the texts. For this session, Ms. Richa Gupta was the resource person.

Day 2: 13 April 2022

SESSION 3: MODERNISM AND POSTMODERNISM

This session outlined how literary works transformed from the mid-19th century to the early 20th century. It reflected the rapidly evolving social conditions that resulted in a significant change in literary aesthetic practices. Further, it introduced the participants to the features of modernist literature and Dr. Aravinda Bhat was the resource person.


SESSION 4: STRUCTURALISM AND POSTSTRUCTURALISM

A session on structuralism and post-structuralism was taken up by Mr. Prathapchandra T wherein he introduced the participants to the features of structuralism and post-structuralism. Selected literary texts were used in the session to demonstrate the readings using modern literary theories. Each session was followed by Q&A where participants put forth their queries.
