Dr. Shikha Jain, Founder Director of DRONAH has an extensive portfolio on cultural heritage of India that covers World Heritage, Cultural Landscapes, Conservation, Heritage based Development and Museum Planning of several projects for the Government of India, State Governments and international organizations such as the Getty Foundation and the World Monuments Fund. As an international expert on World Heritage, she has advised government organizations in Singapore, Malaysia, UAE, Myanmar and UNESCO Offices at Jakarta, Indonesia and Myanmar and, worked as consultant to the UNESCO New Delhi on several missions including nominations and training programs on cultural landscapes. She has steered several UNESCO World Heritage listings in India. She represented India as a Cultural Heritage expert in the UNESCO World Heritage Committee during India’s elected term in Committee from 2011-2015 and, as a bureau member in the 45th World Heritage Committee Session of UNESCO in 2023. She has authored and edited several publications on the cultural heritage of India.

5. Brief Description of the event:

The School of Architecture and Design recently hosted an enlightening expert talk entitled "Urban Design Documentation, Analysis & Intervention" for its 4th-year students and faculty members. Dr. Shikha Jain, a distinguished speaker in the field, delivered a captivating lecture that explored the profound importance of urban design within the context of a heritage city. Throughout her discourse, Dr. Jain emphasized the dynamic nature of urban spaces, asserting that as time progresses, so too does the connotation and symbolism embedded within these spaces.

One of the focal points of Dr. Jain's lecture was the concept of intergenerational transmission. She passionately conveyed how the preceding generation plays a crucial role in passing on the torch of traditions and culture to the succeeding generation. Dr. Jain underscored the importance of this process, hoping that the younger generation would not only receive these

cultural elements but also cultivate a fresh and nuanced understanding. Importantly, she stressed the need for this transmission to occur without exhibiting disrespect or disregard for the rich heritage being handed down.

The event proved to be an invaluable opportunity for students and faculty members of the School of Architecture and Design to gain insights into the complex dynamics of urban design, heritage preservation, and the interplay between generations in shaping the urban fabric. Dr. Shikha Jain's riveting lecture left a lasting impression, sparking thoughtful reflections on the responsibility each generation bears in preserving and evolving the cultural legacy of our cities.
